Communications

PGC Facebook Page: Effective in November, the Facebook group will only be for paying members of the PGC. This is a safe place to post about missing pets, requests to have neighbors look over your house while you're out of town and more.

E-mail Communications: Starting in December, you'll have the ability to receive all neighborhood-wide news (party information, opportunities to learn more about City of Decatur, etc.) — or only opt in to the types of news important to you.

Neighbor Care

Parkwood members have an official welcome committee and mother hen in volunteer Anne Dicks. Anne has been delivering welcome notes and plants or baked goods to new neighbors for several years. This year, she will also help organize MealTrains for new parents and ill neighbors. Parkwood Membership dues fund the modest budget for welcoming new neighbors to our community.

Green Space Maintenance

The PGC funds a monthly maintenance program for the East Lake triangle and traffic circle and the perimeter of Parkwood Park. Although this is by far the largest budget item, the improvement to the neighborhood makes it a very nice investment.



Neighborhood Board

The PGC is guided by a group of elected volunteers who work to keep our neighborhood safe and in good shape. The PGC Board actively pursues neighborhood wide improvements such as sidewalk and pothole repairs, traffic studies and crime prevention.

To put it in perspective, dues are just \$5 a month (about the same as a latte or a beer out!). If you've been a member in the past, we hope you'll join us again this year. If you're new or considering joining for the first time, you're in for a great year!
